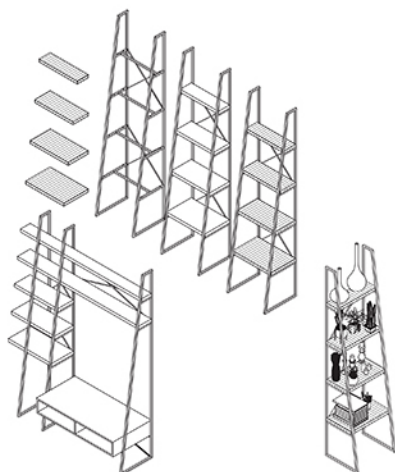

TV8 represents renovation of a housing unit in the building dated from the early 20th century, located in Belgrade's old town. The identity of the space is emphasized by inheritance, representing the values and architectural expression of the past era.
