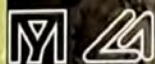

Miloš Komlenić, rođen 1972, docent Arhitektonskog fakulteta Univerziteta u Beogradu. Završio je isti fakultet 1998. diplomiravši radom *Pravoslavni kulturni centar na Kalemegdanu*, za koji je dobio specijalno priznanje *Nikola Dobrović* za najbolji diplomski rad u generaciji.

Na beogradskom Arhitektonskom fakultetu se zaposlio 1996. Danas je angažovan na predmetima Departmana za projektovanje, na osnovnim i master studijama. Kroz svoj autorski rad, kao i u nastavi, bavi se problematikom stanovanja sa specifičnim i posebnim potrebama. Posvećen je i temama savremenog urbanog života i daje veliki doprinos u povezivanju akademskog sektora i društvene zajednice.

Sa značajnim uspehom učestvuje na javnim konkursima, kako u zemlji tako i u inostranstvu, na kojima je dobio više od dvadeset nagrada (devet prvih, četiri druge i četiri treće nagrade, kao i više otkupa i obeštećenja). Veliki broj radova je izlagan i objavljen u stručnoj publicistici.

Dobitnik je Specijalnog priznanja 26. Salona arhitekture (2006) za *Kulturu jezika Likovne prezentacije arhitektonskog rešenja konkursnog projekta*. Dobitnik je Zlatne medalje - priznanja za *Projekat iz stanovanja* na Prvom međunarodnom beloruskom savetovanju za mlade arhitekta *Leonardo 2005*.

Izlagao je radove na samostalnim i grupnim izložbama u zemlji, kao i na međunarodnim izložbama u Belorusiji, Kini i Švedskoj, sa naglaskom na izložbi *Sto godina stanovanja i stambenih politika* u Švedskoj (2016). Realizovao je i autorske izložbe u okviru međunarodne manifestacije BINA (2012. i 2014) *Teksture arhitekture Berlina* i *Teksture moje arhitekture*, kao i u MikroArt galeriji.

Među najznačajnijim izvedenim delima nalaze se stambeno naselje zapadno od ulice Dr Ivana Ribara na Novom Beogradu, starački dom u Valjevu, poslovni objekat *Moninvest* u Budvi, kao i veći broj vila na Crnogorskom primorju. Autor je i autobiografske monografije *U idejama* (2010).

Miloš Komlenić, born in 1972, Assistant Professor at the Faculty of Architecture, University of Belgrade. He graduated from the mentioned faculty in 1998 with his thesis *The Orthodox Cultural Centre in Kalemegdan*, for which he received *Nikola Dobrović* special award for the best graduation thesis

in his generation.

He started working at the Belgrade Faculty of Architecture in 1996. Today, he teaches the courses of Bachelor's and Master's studies at the Design Department. Through his own work, as well as in teaching, he addresses the issue of housing with specific and special needs. He is also dedicated to the topics of modern urban living and he makes a great contribution in connecting the academic sector and the social community.

With significant success, he has participated in public competitions, both in the country and abroad, where he has won over twenty awards (nine first, four second and four third prizes, and earned several purchases and compensations). A large number of his works has been displayed and published in professional journals.

He received the 26<sup>th</sup> Salon of Architecture (2006) special acknowledgement for the *Culture of Language of the Artistic Presentation of the Competition Project Architectural Design*. He won the Gold Medal - recognition for the *Housing Project* at the First International Belorussian Conference for Young Architects *Leonardo 2005*.

He has exhibited his works at solo and group exhibitions in the country, as well as at international exhibitions in Belarus, China and Sweden, the most significant of which was the exhibition *One Hundred Years of Housing and Housing Policies* in Sweden (2016). He had authorial exhibitions as part of the international



event BINA (Belgrade International Architecture Week) (2012 and 2014) entitled *Textures of Berlin Architecture and Textures of My Architecture*, as well as the exhibitions held in the MikroArt Gallery. His most significant realised works are the residential area located west of Dr Ivana Ribara Street in New Belgrade, a nursing home in Valjevo, the *Moninvest* business facility in Budva, as well as a number of villas on the Montenegrin coast. He is also the author of the autobiographical monograph entitled *In Ideas* (2010).

U svojstvu predsednika Stručnog saveta / Žirija učestvuje u organizaciji nacionalnog nastupa Republike Srbije na 14. (2014), 15. (2016), 16.

(2018) i 17. (2020-2021) međunarodnom bijenalu arhitekture u Veneciji. Saradivala na projektima iz istorije srpske arhitekture XX veka u Institutu za istoriju umetnosti Filozofskog fakulteta u Beogradu, Institutu za arhitekturu i urbanizam Srbije, Urbanističkom zavodu grada Beograda. Autor studijskih izložbi *Paralele i kontrasti - srpska arhitektura 1980-2005* (2007) i *Mapiranje identiteta - arhitektura Beograda 1919-2015* (2015) u Muzeju primenjene umetnosti. Učestvovala na međunarodnim naučnim konferencijama i projektima i održala je veći broj javnih predavanja iz oblasti novije srpske arhitekture. Autor je većeg broja naučnih i stručnih radova iz istorije arhitekture XX veka, između ostalih i zapaženih monografija (na srpskom i engleskom): *Arhitektura rezidencija i vila Beograda 1830-2000*, Beograd 2002 i *Paralele i kontrasti - srpska arhitektura 1980-2005*, Beograd 2007. Član je u stručnim i strukovnim udruženjima (Docomomo, ICOM, ULUPUDS). Dobitnik je više nagrada i priznanja.

**Dr. Miroslava Petrović Balubdžić**, arhitekta, doktorirala na Arhitektonskom fakultetu u Beogradu. Bavi se projektovanjem i teorijskim istraživanjem. Od 2001. godine ima status slobodnog umetnika u ULUPUDS-u. Dobitnik je trideset i jedne nagrade na arhitektonskim konkursima, od kojih je dvanaest prvih nagrada. Autor je desetak realizovanih objekata i više urbanističkih celina. Dobitnik je mnogih nagrada i priznanja: *Grand Prix* Salona arhitekture 1994. za realizaciju projekta rekonstrukcije dela centra Užica; Nagrada ULUPUDS-a na Sajmu građevinarstva; nagrada na Urbanističkom salonu u Nišu; Nagrada ULUPUDS-a 2001; Nagrada Salona arhitekture u Beogradu 2007; Nagrada Salona arhitekture u Beogradu 2012; Nagrada A. Šaletić 2013; Godišnja Nagrada DAB-a i SAS-a za realizovano delo 2015. Radila je i kao stručni saradnik u nastavi na Arhitektonskom fakultetu. U Institutu IAUS ima zvanje istraživač saradnik. Učestvovala na brojnim domaćim i stranim naučnim skupovima i konferencijama.

Projekti i tekstovi su objavljeni u publikacijama. Izlagala na više kolektivnih i jednoj samostalnoj izložbi. U oblasti dizajna, realizovala je upotrebne predmete i zapažene izložbene postavke. Osnivač je projektnog studija *Landarh*. Opus obuhvata veliki broj objekata i planova urbane rekonstrukcije, stanovanje, poslovanje, enterijer, uključujući i revitalizaciju industrijskog nasleđa, poput kompleksa Senjski rudnik. Autor je naučne monografije *Reka i gradski prostori u Srbiji* 2013. Rad joj je nominovan za nagradu Evropske unije *Mies van der Rohe Award* 2014. Miroslava Petrović Balubdžić, PhD, an architect, received her PhD degree from the Faculty of Architecture in Belgrade. She pursues her career in design and theoretical research. In 2001, she acquired the status of a freelance artist by ULUPUDS (Association of Applied Arts Artists and Designers of Serbia). She has won thirty-one awards in architectural competitions, twelve of which are the first prizes. She is the author of a dozen constructed facilities and several urban units. She has won many awards and recognitions; 1994 Salon of Architecture *Grand Prix* for the realisation of the project dealing with the reconstruction of part of the centre of Užice; ULUPUDS

Award at the Construction Fair; the Urban Salon Award in Niš; 2001 ULUPUDS Award; 2007 Belgrade Salon of Architecture Award; 2012 Belgrade Salon of Architecture Award; 2013 A. Šaletić Award; 2015 Annual DAB and SAS Award for the realised work. She has also worked as a Teaching Assistant at the Faculty of Architecture. She has the title of research associate at the Institute of Architecture and Urban & Spatial Planning of Serbia. She has participated in many national and international scientific meetings and conferences. Her projects and texts have been published in many journals. She has exhibited her works at several group and one solo exhibition. In the field of design, she has created utility objects and set up remarkable exhibitions. She is a founder of the *Landarh* design studio. Her oeuvre encompasses a great number of facilities and urban reconstruction plans, housing, business, interior design, including the revitalisation of industrial heritage, such as the Senjski rudnik complex. She is the author of the scientific monograph *Rivers and City Space in Serbia*, 2013. Her work was nominated for the European Union *Mies van der Rohe Award* 2014. She was a member of the selection Jury for the performance of the Republic of Serbia at the Venice Biennale in 2014.

**Dejan Todorović**, rođen 1965, diplomirao 1992. na Arhitektonskom fakultetu Univerziteta u Beogradu. Svoju arhitektonsku praksu je započeo u Španiji u kojoj živi i radi između 1993. i 2007; u periodu od 1993. do 1999. ostvaruje saradnju sa više arhitektonskih firmi u Madridu, 1999. osniva sopstvenu arhitektonsku firmu *Off Project* a potom 2004. firmu za dizajn i produkciju *Efecto Guau*. U periodu od 1997. do 2005. obavlja funkcije redovnog profesora na Ai -Etsam (Politehnički fakultet Madrid) i predavača na masteru *Efemerna arhitektura*, Etsam, Politehnički fakultet Madrid. Po povratku u Beograd je osnovao firmu *Efekat Uau* d.o.o. (2006), kao i arhitektonsko dizajnerski studio *NOOTO* (2017). Autor je i kooautor velikog broja realizovanih radova iz različitih oblasti arhitekture (kolektivno stanovanje, socijalno stanovanje, porodične kuće, javni objekti, centri za reciklažu, arhitektonske tematizacije, enterijeri,

efemerna arhitektura, umetničke instalacije), izvedenih uglavnom u Madridu i Beogradu. Ministarstvo kulture i informisanja Republike Srbije ga je imenovalo za Komesara Nastupa Republike Srbije na 16. međunarodnoj izložbi arhitekture *Bijenale u Veneciji* (2018). Najznačajnija priznanja: Nagrada u kategoriji arhitekture 35. Salona arhitekture za Poslovno-stambeni objekat u Bregalničkoj ulici br. 2 u Beogradu (2003); Velika nagrada - Grand Prix 40. Dejan Todorović, born in 1965. He graduated from the Faculty of Architecture at the University of Belgrade in 1992. He began his architectural practice in Spain, where he lived and worked from 1993 to 2007. In

1993-1999 he worked with several architectural firms in Madrid, and in 1999 founded his own architectural company *Off Project* as well as the company for the design and production of *Efecto Guau* (2004). In the period 1997-2005. he is a full-time professor at Ai-Etsam (Madrid School of Polytechnics) and a lecturer at the Masters of *Ephemeral Architecture*, Etsam, Polytechnic College, Madrid. Upon returning to Belgrade he established the company *Efekat Uau* d.o.o. (2006) and the architectural design studio *NOOTO* (2017). He is the author and co-author of a large number of realized works from various areas of architecture (collective housing, social housing, family houses, public buildings, recycling centers, architectural themes, interiors, ephemeral architecture, art installations), mainly in Madrid and Belgrade. From the Ministry of Culture and Information of the Republic of Serbia he was appointed as the Commissioner of the Republic of Serbia at the 16<sup>th</sup> International Exhibition of Architecture Biennale in Venice (2018). While she was working in the architectural studio bearing the same name, she had an opportunity to cooperate with the Faculty of Architecture full-time professors - Borislav Petrović and Ivan Rašković. Together with the authors of the AGM team, she has designed and constructed a great number of facilities and carried out spatial and programme studies in various fields (sports and infrastructure facilities, business/production and residential facilities, facilities in protected monument zones). She has participated in many architectural and urban planning competitions, including several international ones, where she received twenty-six

awards and won other prizes, fourteen of which were the first prizes. We have, more or less successfully, exited the period when the flats' walls were occupied by numerous paintings, graphic prints, even Gobelins as well as meticulously framed reproductions of various objects that all together dominated portraits and still lifes. These artworks depicted a great variety of objects - from well-known religious buildings, through countryside mills, anonymous houses, all the way to the landscapes of Montmartre and Gardoš. All of them were situated on a couple of walls and were hung in order in which they entered the house and not in any logic order. Not a single work was moved in case the nail did not fit it. Not a single work had ever been taken off except when it was time to paint the walls. And the more frames, the better - perhaps for the owner's status. As children, it bothered us that our heroes from comics, and later from the rock & roll world, were not standing in those frames. However, we grew up next to these works and thus inevitably and unconsciously learned about architecture. All of us. Today, rarely anyone paints objects, and even less often they hang them on the walls of their flats. Old paintings end up next to a container or in a basement, replaced by an abstraction of life in the form of Instagram, while Đole Balašević's songs are still hummed around. And these songs are not

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## OBJEKAT VIŠEPORODIČNOG STANOVANJA

*Stambeni objekat 1. u okviru Projekta urbane regeneracije naselja u Dositejevoj ulici u Kraljevu*

Objekat je izgrađen u sklopu prve faze obnove naselja u Dositejevoj ulici u Kraljevu, teško oštećenog u zemljotresu 2010. godine.

Projekat je izrađen kao razrada pobjedničkog rešenja sa konkursa za rekonstrukciju naselja iz 2015. godine, koji su organizovali Grad Kraljevo i Ministarstvo GSI Republike Srbije uz podršku Udruženja arhitekata Srbije i Fonda za razvoj Zapadnog Balkana WBIF-IPF3.

Naselje se rekonstruiše u tri faze, od kojih svaka podrazumeva naizmenično zidanje novih objekata i rušenje postojećih zgrada, neuslovnih za stanovanje, tako da korisnici dobiju ili skromno doplate stan za stan, sve do realizacije ukupno 366 novih stambenih jedinica i preseljenja svih ugroženih porodica.

U okviru Objekta 1. projektovano je 106 stanova čija struktura i površina odgovaraju potrebama za preseljenja stanovnika jedne četvrtine naselja. Projektnim zadatkom predviđeno je da korisnici dobijaju stambenu jedinicu najpribližnije ili nešto veće površine u odnosu na onu koju trenutno imaju u vlasništvu u oštećenim zgradama. Dodatno, jedinice su projektovane prema zahtevu da se omogući njihovo dalje pregrađivanje, kako bi ih višečlane porodice lakše prilagodavale svojim potrebama.
