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

Izazov projekta je bio da se sa veoma ograničenim sredstvima postigne kvalitetna arhitektura koja ispodno barista osnovnim arhitektonskim elementima, a to su stubovi, zidovi, ploče i čtvoči, kako bi se napravila prozračna unutrašnja volumetrija sa pročišćenom konstrukcijom primerena izložbenom salonu i, relativno stroga, poslovna spoljašnjost objekta sa ritmičnim fasadnim otvorima. Istočno orijentisana glavna fasada omogućava dobru osvetljenost

izložbenog prostora tokom celog dana, a da sunce direktno ulazi u objekat samo u jutarnjim časovima, čime se eliminiše potreba za korišćenjem zasebno koji bi kompromitovali izložbeni karakter objekta. Ulazne zone su naznačene uvlačenjem objekta i pažljivim pozicioniranjem zidnih platna, čime se jasno diferenciraju ulazi za posećioce salona, ulazi za zaposlene i za pristupanje podzemnoj garaži.

Open

The Council of the Salon of Architecture announces the topic of the 38th Salon of Architecture called "Open".

The question "What are we witnessing?" represents the basis of this year's Salon topic. The Salon's Council intends to bring the issue of pressure placed upon the world of architecture, which results in general disorientation, conformism, particularism, anarchism and nihilism, into the public focus.

The adjective "open" – talking openly, honestly and clearly about something, is used with the intention of articulating an affirmative criticism of the current situation, and in favour of opening a new perspective to the world of architecture. After last year's topic of "affirmation", the Salon's Council wishes that, this time, once again, the Salon of Architecture, as the most important event in the field of architecture in Serbia, took significant public participation in articulating the affirmative opinion on the world of architecture.

Miodrag Mitrasinović je arhitekt, urbanist i autor. Miodrag je vanredni profesor urbanizma i arhitekture na Parsons School of Design, Univerziteta New School, gde predaje na Katedri za urbanizam u okviru diplomskih studija. Miodragov naučni rad je usmeren na dva paralelna i komplementarna toka istraživanja. Prvi, o ulozi dizajna kao činioca društvene i političke promene, i kao katalizatora za kritične urbane transformacije; njegovo istraživanje se zalaže za važnost, centralno mesto, projektovanja u konceptualizaciji, proizvodnji i zastupanju demokratskog i participativnog urbanog prostora. Drugo, njegov rad se takođe usredsređuje na generativne kapacitete i infrastrukturne dimenzije javnog prostora posebno, na ukrštanju javne politike, urbanog i javnog dizajna i procesa privatizacije javnih resursa. On je autor *Total Pejzaž*, tematski parkovi, javni prostor (Ashgate 2006), ko-urednik *Putovanja, prostor, Arhitektura* (Ashgate 2009.) i urednik u *Concurrent Urbanities: Projektiranje infrastrukture uključivanja* (Routledge 2016). Miodrag Mitrasinović is an architect, urbanist and author. Miodrag is an associate professor of Urbanism and Architecture at Parsons School of Design, The New School university, where he currently serves as Chair of Urban Graduate Programs. Miodrag's scholarly work focuses on two parallel and complementary lines of inquiry. First, on the role design plays as an agent of social and political change, and as catalyst for critical urban transformations; his research argues for the centrality of designing in the conceptualization, production, and representation of democratic and participatory urban space. Secondly, Miodrag's work also focuses on the generative capacity and infrastructural dimensions of public space specifically at the intersections of public policy, urban and public design, and processes of privatization of public resources. He is the author of *Total Landscape, Theme Parks, Public Space* (Ashgate 2006), co-editor of *Travel, Space, Architecture* (Ashgate 2009) and editor of *Concurrent Urbanities: Designing Infrastructures of Inclusion* (Routledge 2016). Žiri 38. Salona arhitekture konstatuje da je za ovogodišnji Salon kandidovano 230 radova u svim kategorijama. Žiri je u zvaničnu selekciju uvrstio 109 radova, od čega je u konkurenciji za nagrade razvrstano 83 rada u 6 kategorija.
